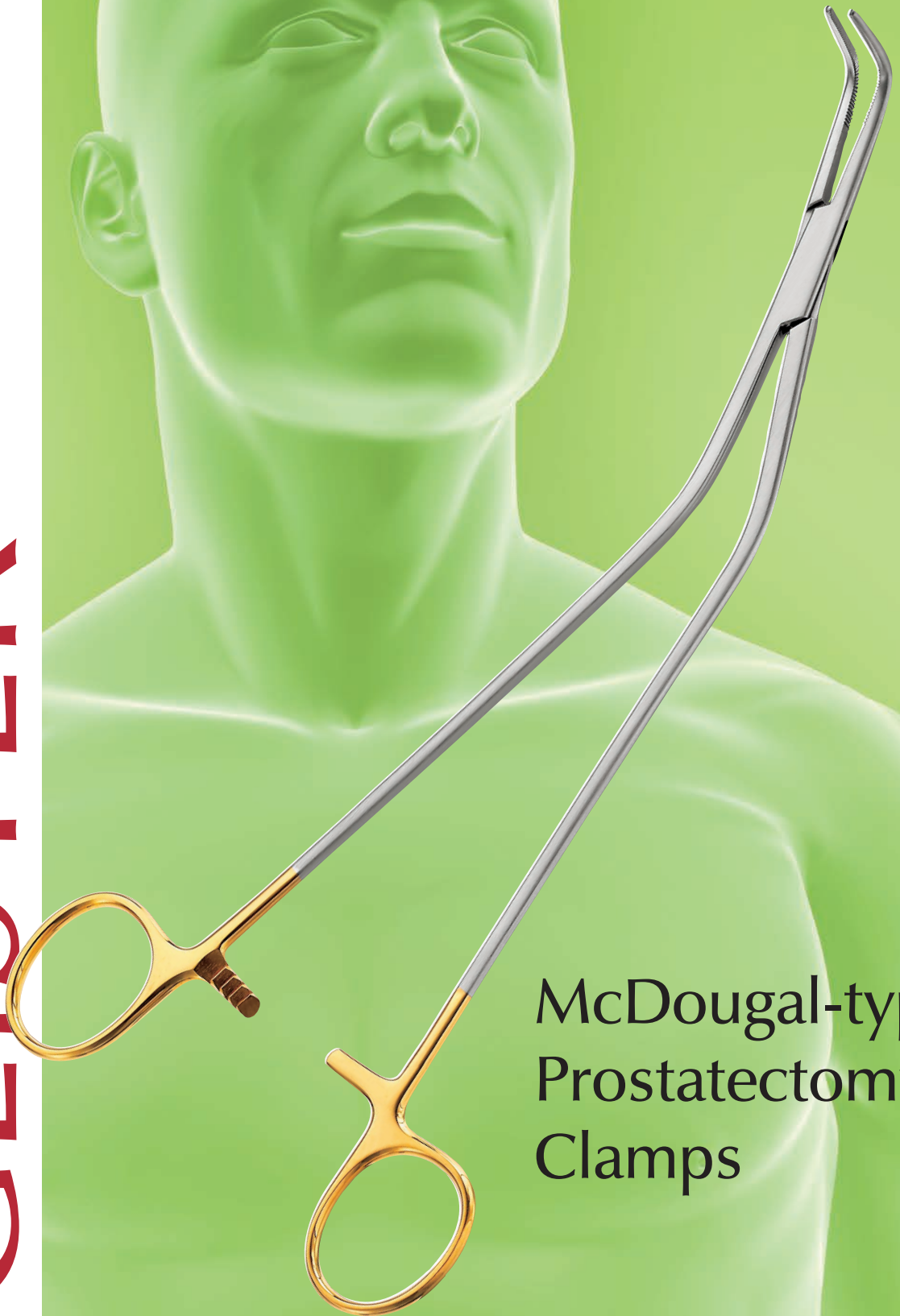

McDougal-type

Clamps



A special designed clamp used for dissection of the dorsal vein complex during radical retropubic prostatectomy procedures in Urology.

Cross-serrated with 2cm jaws. Secures the dorsal vein complex during radical retropubic prostatectomy. Also useful for other deep retropubic or deep pelvic work when approached from the abdomen. It's special design always allows easy access in operative site obstructed by the pubis or other structures. The clamp is positioned beneath the dorsal vein complex and surrounding striated urethral musculature. Then the dorsal vein can be ligated and divided or divided without ligation. If the clamp has been placed in the correct plane, the dorsal vein can be divided completely with little residual bleeding.
